The Lancaster Chamber of Commerce will select students for work ethics scholarships starting at \$500.00, with a range to be determined by the number of sponsors. **To be eligible**, a student must:

- be a senior in high school in the Antelope Valley scheduled to graduate by June 2019 with a minimum GPA of 2.5 (un-weighted).
- be working part-time in a local business or training in a paid or unpaid internship during the 2018/19 school year.
- be able to describe how you demonstrate positive work ethics.
- plan to be enrolled in a college or technical school by the fall of 2019.

To apply & be eligible:

Complete and submit the application no **later than** March 29, 2019. Applications are available online at www.lancasterchamber.org or at the Lancaster Chamber of Commerce office.

Attach a letter of reference from the supervisor which:

- is typed on the company letterhead and is addressed to the Lancaster Chamber Career Education Committee.
- describes applicant's duties or training.
- describes how the employee or intern (applicant) displays positive work ethics which makes student a good employee.
- recommends applicant for this scholarship.

Attach a one (1) page typed essay not to exceed 500 words that includes:

- 12-point font, double-spaced
- Your definition of Work Ethics
- How you demonstrate a positive work ethic on your job, internship, or community service
- Your career plans and educational goals

Attach a copy of your transcript.

Attach a copy of your resume, extracurricular activities, and other accolades.
